## **PPRC PRESS RELEASE 29<sup>th</sup> JULY 2025**

Pursuant to its Constitutional and Statutory Mandate, the Political Parties Regulation Commission (PPRC) will deploy its staff to monitor the National Delegate Conference for the Election of National Officers of the Sierra Leone People's Party (SLPP) scheduled for July 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2025.

The leadership and membership of the SLPP are hereby admonished to conduct themselves within the provisions of the SLPP Constitution of 11<sup>th</sup> August 2020; the 5<sup>th</sup> February 2021 Rules and Regulations for the Conduct of All Executive Elections for the SLPP; the Constitution of Sierra Leone (Act No.6) 1991; the Political Parties Act (Act No. 25) 2022 and the Public Order Act (Act No. 46) 1965.

**Furthermore**, the Commission hereby encourages the leadership, membership and supporters of the SLPP to ensure that these elections are held in line with Section 35 (2) of the Constitution of Sierra Leone 1991, Act No. 6 of 1991 which states; "***The internal organisation of a political party shall conform to democratic principles, and its aims, objectives, purposes and programmes shall not contravene, or be inconsistent with, any provisions of this Constitution***".

Finally, members are advised to channel all concerns to the appropriate authorities as provided by law.
