

## PPRC News Brief 10<sup>th</sup> February 2016



The Chairman of the Political Parties Registration Commission (PPRC) Hon. Justice M.E. Tolla Thompson on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> February 2016 assured staff of the Commission's commitment in ensuring the planned activities for 2016 are achieved.

Hon. Justice Thompson made this statement at the end of the two days annual review retreat at the Commission's headquarters, Tower Hill in Freetown. He admonished staff to continue the Commission's work with independence, impartiality and integrity. This he says will help in rebranding of the image of the Commission.

At the end of the two days retreat, the Commission developed work plan inclusive of timelines and budget on the following deliverables:

- Training of Political Parties Leadership on organizational efficiency;
- Town Hall meetings with members of Parliament in their Constituencies;
- Review of the Political Parties Act of 2002;

- Four Regional Review meetings with Political Parties;
- Engagement with Religious Leaders, Opinion Leaders and CSO's and;
- Verification of Political Party Offices and books of account.

The retreat brought together staff from Bo, Kenema, Makeni, Kono and Freetown.
