



PPRC News Brief 5th November 2015



The Political Parties Registration Commission (PPRC) on Thursday 5th November 2015 refused to award the Provisional Certificate of Registration to the NATIONAL PROGRESSIVE DEMOCRAT (NPD) due to the absence of the Interim Leader/Chairman Alimamy Cyllah. This disclosure was made by the Chairman of the Commission Hon. Justice M.E. Tolla Thompson when addressing a cross section of the party's executive and their legal representative.

Addressing the meeting, Hon. Justice Thompson says registering a political party is not the same as registering a company. Political Parties he says are a creation of the 1991 Constitution and that the Commission will not award the certificate to any other executive member except the Interim Leader/Chairman of the party.

In his response, the Deputy Interim Chairman/Leader, Wadi Williams accepted the Commissions' position and promised to get back to the Commission when the Interim Chairman/Leader arrives in Sierra Leone.
