

PPRC ON SLPP PETITION

The Political Parties Registration Commission (PPRC) has completed listening to submissions on Petitions sent by Ambassador Allie Bangura and sixteen others from the Sierra Leone Peoples Party (SLPP).

After the Party's 2013 Delegate Conference in Bo, the Commission received petitions against the conduct and the outcome of the convention.

After listening to the final submission, the Chairman Hon Justice M.E. Tolla Thompson says the Commission will now sit and look at the issues and will come up with a recommendation on the matter.

PPRC SETS TO MONITOR BY ELECTIONS IN KAILAHUN AND TONKOLILI DISTRICTS

The Political Parties Registration Commission PPRC is set to monitoring the By Election in Constituency 01 in Kailahun District and Local Council By Election in Ward 229 in Sambaia Bendugu in Tonkolili District.

The deployment will include Permanent Staff, members of the District Code Monitoring Committees and casual staff.

This is in line with the Commissions mandate to monitor the conduct of Political Parties on Elections Day.

Meanwhile the Commission is currently engaged in the Formalization of the Executive of the All Political Parties Youth Association (APPYA) in the Northern District.
