## PPRC NEWS BRIEF 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2019

The Leadership of the All Peoples Congress (APC) Party, the National Grand Coalition (NGC) Party and the Sierra Leone People's Party (SLPP) on Friday 1st March 2019 reaffirmed their commitment to a peaceful outcome in the forthcoming re-run of the by-election in Ward 196, Tonko-Limba Chiefdom, Kambia District.

Witnessed by the PPRC, the three parties together with the National Electoral Commission (NEC), the Office of National Security (ONS) and the Sierra Leone Police (SLP) signed a Memorandum of Understanding on Tuesday 26th February, 2019 ahead of the re-run bye-election in Ward 196 in the Tonko-Limba Chiefdom Kambia District on Saturday 9th March, 2019.

In a meeting held in Masunthu village in the Kambia District on Friday 1st March 2019, the political party leaders expressed regret over the incidents that happened on the 29th September 2018 which led to the death of the 14 year old boy and the cancellation of the election by the NEC.

They pledged their commitment to a peaceful process as stated in the MOU and to graciously accept the outcome of the election.

The meeting organised by the Political Parties Registration Commission (PPRC) was attended by NEC, ONS, SLP, the All Political Parties Association (APPA), the All Political Parties Women's Association (APPWA), the All Political Parties Youth Association (APPYA), the Resident Minister North/West Region, the Paramount Chief and Section Chiefs, the candidates and the indigenes of Ward 196.
