



## PPRC PRESS RELEASE – 3<sup>rd</sup> September, 2020

The attention of the Political Parties Registration Commission (hereinafter called "the PPRC") is drawn to the several misinterpretations and distortions of the contents of its Press Statements of the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> April 2020 respectively.

Consequently, the PPRC hereby makes the following clarifications:-

- 1. That the Commission has not ban Party activities, we do not hold such pretensions.
- 2. That the clear intention of our said Press Statements, is to ADMONISH AND CALL on Political Parties, to pay strict heed to the law and the CoViD 19 Regulations, in the conduct of their activities and as a Regulatory Body, we continue to stand on that stead.
- 3. That it is for the leadership of each Party to design their programmes in a manner consistent with the law and the said Regulations.
- 4. That it is the exclusive preserve of NaCoVERC and Security Sector Actors, to determine whether or not a Public activity is in contravention of the CoViD 19 Regulations and/or safety measures.
- 5. Consequently, in addition to their traditional invitees, Political Parties are requested to extend an invitation to NaCoVERC, to any public activity they are undertaking.
