## PPRC PRESS RELEASE 14th JUNE, 2024



The Inter-Party Dialogue Committee was established out of resolution five (5) of the 'Agreement for National Unity" signed by the Government of Sierra Leone and the All Peoples Congress (APC) to institutionalise an inter-party framework.

In a meeting held on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> June, 2024 at the New Brookfield's Hotel in Freetown, the leadership of sixteen (16) registered political parties agreed to work together for peace, unity and national cohesion. These political parties also discussed the Terms of Reference for the Inter Party Dialogue Committee.



Before agreeing on actions points to be taken immediately, the National Secretary General of the Sierra Leone Peoples Party, Umaru Napoleon Koroma Esq. and the Deputy National Secretary General of the All Peoples Congress (APC) Osman Abdel Timbo Esq. took the podium and read the joint press statement signed by both parties condemning hate speech and violence.

The 16 parties present agreed on the following:

- 1. To popularise the Joint Press Statement signed by the SLPP and APC condemning hate speech and violence
- 2. To hold joint outreach programme using radio and TV amongst others

The leaders of the political parties present further committed themselves to peace and to do all such that will promote national cohesion and political stability.
